



Pennsylvania Department of Education Career Ready PA Backpack Challenge – How to Participate!

- ✓ Register by April 30 at this link: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/Backpack2023>! (or link to the QR code above) All schools in PA will receive a Remake Learning Days regional event brochure in early April from their regional Career Ready PA liaison (see [map](#) with email link).
- ✓ Join the April webinar hosted by your Career Ready PA liaison and check for emails with **Remake Learning Days Backpack Challenge** in the subject line for updates!
- ✓ Events listed on the [Remake Learning Days website](https://remakelearningdays.org/pa-career-ready) (<https://remakelearningdays.org/pa-career-ready>) tagged with the “backpack” qualify for the Challenge.
- ✓ Follow the easy steps on the Remake Learning website! Make sure you (your student/s) submit their digital artifact survey **after** the event to get credit for their badge and career portfolio artifact! It’s easy and only takes a few minutes to complete by clicking the survey link in Step 4 on the website.
- ✓ Your Remake Ready Pack includes 50 starter sticker badges to give to students immediately after participating in an event. If you need more, just email your [Career Ready PA liaison](#), as identified on the clickable [map](#).
- ✓ If your school earns 100+ badges, your school will be awarded a BANNER!
- ✓ Registered schools will receive via email a password-protected spreadsheet of participants who submitted the digital artifact survey (badge) by May 26, 2023. (one point of contact per school)
- ✓ The spreadsheet can be used as documentation for the portfolios. Evidence can be noted as “**Career Ready PA Backpack Challenge**” in the student portfolio.

Ideas for participation:

- 1) Share brochures with you parent-teacher organization and encourage a Remake Learning Day Career Ready PA Backpack Challenge event, e.g., badge awards day.
- 2) Teachers can show a Career Ready PA Backpack Challenge Remake Learning Day event in class as part of instruction. Students submit an artifact survey after participation for credit.
- 3) Families can encourage children to enjoy a Remake Learning Days after-school event for live participation at home. Students can submit the artifact digitally outside of the school day.
- 4) Entire schools can select a Remake Learning Day Career Ready Backpack Challenge time and participate in multiple events at once!
- 5) When the Challenge is over, schools can choose to celebrate badge awards with a festival, movie, outdoor activities, cafeteria ice cream vouchers, etc., with the support of the PTO or community partner.
