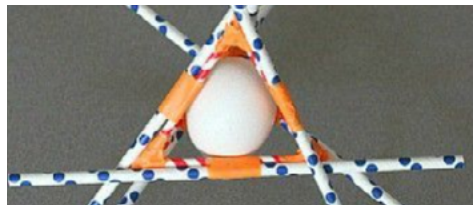

Girih tiles were a feature of Islamic architecture starting around the year 1200, reflecting the complex mathematics of the cultures of that time. Girih means "knot" in Persian. The tiles are shaped with specific angles and could be used to make non-repeating patterns. Participants will color and cut out Girih tiles and make designs by gluing them onto construction paper.
